Singer Information

- I. **Membership Dues** entitle you to participate in three scheduled choral concerts during the season, as well as to participate in various other choral activities, including joint concerts with other arts organizations and the annual D-Day Memorial Concert.
 - A. Annual membership: \$75 for 3 concerts
 - B. Per concert membership: \$25 each.

- II. **Music Fee** entitles you to borrow music for the current season with the understanding that all music will be returned after each concert free of any permanent markings. Music should only be marked in pencil. No highlighting, colored pencils, or ink pens of any kind should be used. *(If preferred, music may be copied, and singers may then mark on their own copies according to personal preferences.)*
 - A. Annual fee: \$30 for 3 concerts or \$10 per concert
 - B. Special rate of \$25 if paid in full in September of each season

- III. **Concert Attire**
 - A. **Men** wear classic black tuxedos with black bow ties and black shoes and socks.
 - B. **Women** wear either a floor length black dress (Georgette Dress #8650, \$59.00) or a floor length black skirt with a black scoop neck top. The Amadeus Jacket #8718, \$36.00, is required to be worn over this ensemble and must be ordered online at www.stageaccents.com or by calling 1-800-631-1611. Accessories include a medium length strand of pearls and small pearl earrings or pearl studs; black hose, and black shoes.
 - C. Members are reminded to refrain from wearing anything scented to both rehearsals and performances.
 - D. Black music folders are required. You may order folders with names engraved on them through soprano Lynne Weaver. Plain black 3-ring binders are acceptable substitutes.

- IV. **Rehearsal Attendance** is recorded by Section Leaders each week. Rehearsal time is critical for both you, your section, and the entire group. During a given season, you will be informed of the number of rehearsals scheduled prior to a concert and the number you may miss and still be eligible to sing in the concert. During the winter months, rehearsals cancelled due to inclement weather will be rescheduled for a Saturday. Singers suffering with colds or sinus problems are encouraged to attend rehearsals and sit out in the sanctuary so that they can follow along in their music. Singers are asked to be sure to check in with your Section Leader each week.
